November Sponsor Trip

Preparations are already underway for the November Sponsor Trip. These visits provide an opportunity to experience the program firsthand, build relationships with students and staff, and see the daily impact taking place.

This trip is designed for people of all ages, and we especially have a heart to make it accessible for older sponsors. The focus is not on physically demanding work, but on meaningful connection, spending time with the children, participating in simple activities like crafts, helping serve meals, and working alongside staff in the kitchen. You will have the opportunity to lead school chapels for all grade levels while you are there. It is a relaxed and relational environment centered on presence and engagement.

Sponsors will also have the opportunity to visit their child's home, walk or travel with them to school, and spend meaningful time together. It is a chance to bring small gifts for the child and their family and to experience the relationship in a personal way. These moments are deeply meaningful, and many who visit leave with a clearer understanding of the impact their support is making in the lives of these children and the mission being carried forward through them.



Easter Across Our Campuses

Easter was celebrated across our campuses through the showing of a film depicting the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus in the local language of Changana. On Good Friday, hundreds from the community gathered, many hearing the story of Christ in their own language.

Our program students were actively involved, inviting others and participating in the outreach. The celebration continued on Sunday with church services across our campuses, where several teachers and students took the next step in their faith journey through baptism. It was a powerful weekend of community, worship, and life change as families gathered to celebrate the hope of the resurrection.
