TEAM VISITS

We welcomed the first team from North Carolina led by Kathryn Sorensen during the week of March 7, 2026. Although the team had only 9 people, they were able to bring 35 wheelchairs and other supplies on Delta Airlines. The team did health screenings of our students, provided therapy sessions, made assignments for new students, and checked on our Starlink internet connection.

Pastor Bill Hegedus's team visited April 20-29. The team of 5 organized Bible studies with the students in the afternoons and the Jesus Story rehearsals in the evenings from Sunday to Wednesday. They helped the church to perform the Jesus Story play on Thursday and Friday nights and a dedicated performance for children on Saturday morning. It was a blessing to see new members joining the cast and a full audience.

STUDENT UPDATE

Ten of our students, 5 girls and 5 boys, graduated on May 8, 2026. For the first time, two of them, because of their disabilities, were given accommodation so they could take the 6th grade Basic Education Certificate Examination by allowing them to read the questions themselves, giving them answer choices and allowing them to shade the answers instead of writing the answers! We are waiting to see their results. We ask for your prayers for all the candidates that they will gain admission to high schools.

MTC went on Easter break from April 2-24th. There are 120 students in the basic level, with 52 boarders and 68 day-students. Twenty girls and 32 boys board at MTC, while the day-students number 16 girls and 52 boys.

We currently have 52 students on our website portal, six of whom have no sponsorship. Now 11 students are co-sponsored and 35 have full sponsorship. We are also expecting 4 new students who went through the assessment process to start school next term.

The Junior High School building project is progressing steadily. The electrical and ceiling installations are complete. Painting is almost done as we are waiting for the final cutting and polishing of the terrazzo floor. We still need to install windows, doors, and landscape. Hopefully by summer, it will be finished.

NEW VENTURES

By the grace of God and the support of all of you, we have now installed solar electricity in our main building, which has nine 600-watt solar panels. We are evaluating its effectiveness and considering adding more panels to extend the power to other buildings at the school. So far, the solar system is working better than expected.
