INTERNATIONAL SERVE DAY



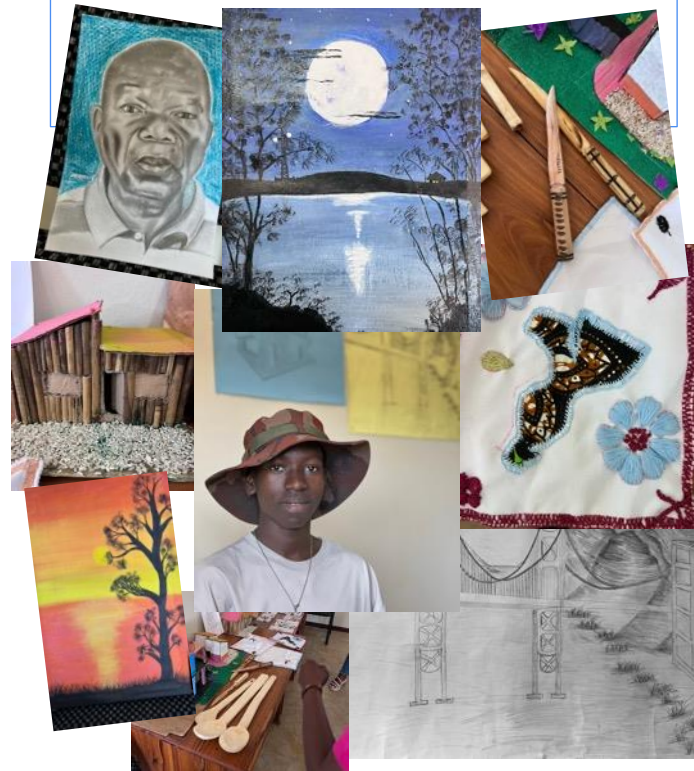
